Educational Programme

Based on the Learning outcomes defined before, the Green Digital partners produced the following training programme. The Training programme was divided in 3 different sessions as follows:

Session 1:

The first session aimed at introducing the main topic of ICT sustainability defining the ecological impact of ICTs and the benefits of sustainability practices.

Training programme:

- Provide a definition of ICT Sustainability (1h)
- ICTs' ecological impact: trends and statistics (1h)
- The benefits of ICTs sustainability actions: concrete examples and case studies (2h)





Session 2

The second session aimed at equipping the participants with the right skills to act in practice, promoting ICT sustainability in companies. The last part of the session is dedicated to understanding how to create an ICT sustainability plan, encouraging participants to create their own plan.
